Part B

Part B consists of four staves of music. The first staff has a C chord above the first measure, a C7 chord above the second measure, and F chords above the third and fourth measures. The second staff has G chords above the first and second measures, a C chord above the third measure, and a G chord above the fourth measure. The third staff has C chords above the first and second measures, and F chords above the third and fourth measures. The fourth staff has G chords above the first, second, and third measures, and a C chord above the fourth measure. Fingerings and slurs are indicated throughout the piece.

Part C*

Part C* consists of four staves of music. The first staff has Am chords above the first and second measures, and Dm chords above the third and fourth measures. The second staff has G chords above the first and second measures, a C chord above the third measure, and a G chord above the fourth measure. The third staff has Am chords above the first and second measures, a Dm chord above the third measure, and a slide-off instruction above the fourth measure. The fourth staff has G chords above the first and second measures, a Gp chord above the third measure, and a C chord above the fourth measure. Fingerings, slurs, and a slide-off instruction are indicated throughout the piece.
