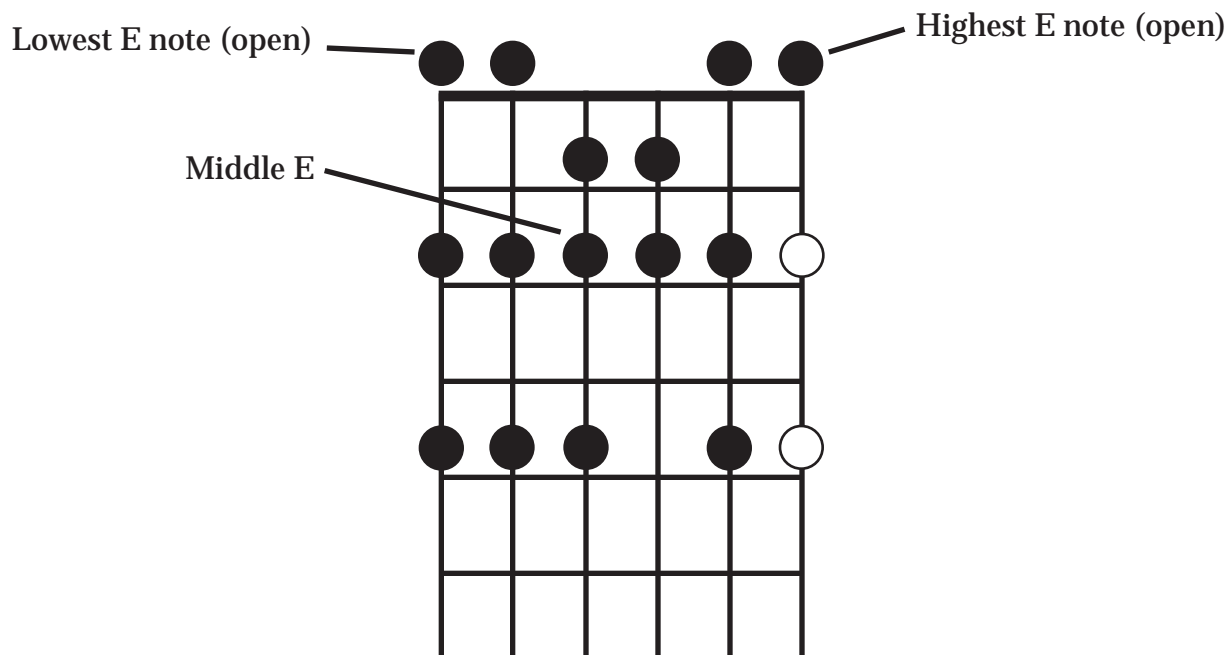


E Major Scale

In 1st Position



Dots represent fingertips on the guitar fingerboard. Each dot is a note in the E major scale. Black dots signify the E scale from the low E note to the highest E note in 1st position. White dots signify notes within the E scale that are below the lowest E note. Practice the scale 2 ways: 1) play the black dots only, one at a time (lowest to highest then back to the lowest again -repeat many times); 2) play the white and black notes, one at a time, beginning at the lowest note (top, left black dot), all the way through to the highest note (bottom, right white dot), and then back down to the lowest note again -repeat many times (see notation/tablatore version below). All E notes are indicated below.

Repeat Sign: this means to repeat the scale over and over again until fluent
